1. **Outbreak:** a sudden increase in the occurrence of a disease
2. **Potable:** suitable for drinking
3. **Crest:** an upper part, edge or limit <the crest of a riverbed>
4. **Pandemic:** an outbreak that occurs worldwide and affects many people
5. **Emergency:** an unexpected situation that calls for immediate action; an urgent need for help
 - a. Examples: an explosion, a building collapse, a blackout
6. **Disaster:** something that happens suddenly and causes loss of life and property.
 - a. Examples: a flood, a wildfire, a blizzard, a disease, a hurricane, a tornado, extreme heat
7. **Prepared:** to make ready beforehand; to put together the elements of
8. **Disease:** an unhealthy condition of the body
9. **Plan:** a drawing showing the parts of something; a method of doing something
10. **Mitigate:** to make less dangerous
